

Summer University Experience - Drew in the City

This 3-week program is designed for high school students looking to experience a highly interactive American university education while improving their English and exploring the best New York has to offer.

Description

The Summer University Experience offers international participants ages 15 - 18 the opportunity to tour the Drew University, INTO Drew and the surrounding New York and New Jersey area.

Participants will practice their English language skills while attending language workshops, educational field trips, conversation partner meetings, and recreational events as well as become familiar with university life and interact with students and faculty on Drew's campus.

You will enjoy full access to all university facilities, and experienced counselors will provide guidance and supervision at all times.

Trips and Activities

Learn about American culture and history as you take educational field trips around the area. Some examples of places you will visit:

- New York City: See historical landmarks, world-renowned architecture and a diverse set of cultural and culinary hot spots. Visit sites like Times Square, the Empire State Building, Rockefeller Center, the Metropolitan Museum of Art and much more.
- Surrounding New Jersey area: Visit the Woodbury Commons outlet mall, Shakespeare Theatre, Six Flags Great Adventure and other local attractions.
- Nearby historic Philadelphia: Home to the Liberty Bell, Independence Hall (where the Declaration of Independence and US Constitution were signed) and many other sites important to American history.

Fees

\$3,800* per three-week session. Includes:

- Round-trip transportation to and from the airport
- Chaperones for all activities and events
