Business travellers from Dunedin will have nearly six hours on the ground in Auckland, with the last direct flight heading south at 5.15pm. A full business day is also available through the morning one-stop option via Wellington.

The changes will make it easier for people flying in and out of Dunedin to connect with international destinations across Air New Zealand's growing international network.

The new services and schedules offer better connections for international flights, with more choices and greatly improved Asia, Pacific Island and trans-Tasman connectivity. Passengers travelling to China, Japan, as well as North and South America will benefit from reduced transit times and more connecting flight options.
