

International Education Scholarship Information 2017

Canning College is offering a number of prestigious scholarships for international students to undertake the Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) or Year 12 Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) program at Canning College in Perth, Western Australia (WA). Applicants from all countries will be eligible for consideration.

Scholarship winners are selected on the basis of academic results and a reference from the school. Where academic results do not allow for differentiation between applicants, resumes or curriculum vitae will be considered.

Scholarships apply for Year 12 level courses; WA Universities' Foundation Program and the Western Australian Certificate of Education Program.

Students can nominate the scholarship to apply to:

January Entry 2017: WAUFP and WACE April Entry 2017: WAUFP and WACE Mid-Year Entry 2017/18: WAUFP

Year 11 students at Canning College may apply for an award on the basis of their Year 11 results. (Contact the ISO).

The closing date for all January Entry 2017 scholarship applications will be 31 October 2016. Notifications will be issued within two weeks of the closing date.

Full Scholarship: January Entry 2017

ONE (1) Full Scholarship covering the course fee of A\$23,115 will be awarded.

To be awarded a full scholarship requires a student to have achieved outstanding academic results. This would normally require the student to have achieved the highest possible grade in at least **six** (6) relevant subjects.

Students will be required to complete an International Student Application Form, an International Scholarship Application Form and pay an A\$200 non-refundable fee. The A\$200 fee will be deducted from the student's tuition fees in the event of not gaining any scholarship but enrolling at Canning College for 2016.

Additional documentation required:

- 1. Reference from the school principal.
- 2. Actual or mock/forecast/preliminary results for major examinations equivalent to Year 11 in Western Australia.
- 3. Two (2) most recent school reports.
- 4. Curriculum Vitae or resume.

Partial Scholarships

Five (5) scholarships to the value of A\$10,000 Six (6) scholarships to the value of A\$7,000 These awards would normally require the str

These awards would normally require the student to have achieved the highest possible grade in at least **five (5)** relevant subjects.

These scholarships may be offered to students at anytime, including during marketing visits. Such students must pay a non-refundable deposit of A\$1,000 within **two** (2) weeks of the offer or forfeit the scholarship.

Students accepting one of these scholarships will also be considered for a full scholarship and the A\$1,000 deposit will be transferred to course fees paid.

There is no application fee for a partial scholarships awarded by College staff during overseas marketing visits.

Any scholarship funds not allocated during overseas marketing visits will be awarded at the same time as the full scholarship is decided.

Any students wanting to be considered in October/November are required to pay the A\$200 non-refundable fee as outlined in the conditions for applying for a full scholarship.

Notification of success or otherwise will be by 18 November 2016.

Canning College, in Western Australia, is offering a number of scholarships for international students studying either the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) or the Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) at Canning College in Perth. These scholarships are of two types: full course fee exemption scholarship (valued at A\$23,115) and partial scholarships of A\$10,000 or A\$7,000.

Conditions

- 1. Students must have lodged an Application Form with the International Office at Canning College by 31 October 2016.
- 2. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and school recommendation as judged by a selection panel of College representatives. Once a scholarship is awarded, no other financial benefits (e.g. family bursary) apply.
- 3. Scholarship students who withdraw after 4 weeks of commencement of the course forfeit any refund of fees.

Applications

- 1. Please complete the details below. You need to attach the following:
 - Recent academic results which equate to Year 11 in Perth. The following are examples only, and **applicants from all countries are** eligible. Below are examples only.

Singapore, Brunei : 'O' Levels or results of preliminary examinations equivalent to O Levels.

Malaysia : Forecast SPM **or** completed SPM; Senior Middle 2 results.

Indonesia : Year 11

Hong Kong : HKDSE or Form 5 Kenya : KCSE or O Levels

Zambia : Zambia Certificate of Education/O Levels

Zimbabwe : O Levels Vietnam : Year 11

Include your two most recent school reports with any predicted or mock results.
