#### Entry requirements for Stage 1 pathway leading to the MPharm

Country	Entry requirements (Foundation)
China	Completion of Senior Middle 2: minimum 70%
GCC States (Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, UAE)	Completion of Tawjahiya/Thanawiya: minimum 60% average
Hong Kong	Successful Completion of Form 5 with an average of 40–55% (depending on school's banding) in Form 4 and Form 5
Kenya	KCSE/CSE: Five passes
Malaysia	SPM: Three passes with a minimum of Grade D
Nigeria	SSCE (WAEC/NECO/NABTEB): Five passes at minimum D7
Tanzania	IGCSE/CSE: Minimum Five passes or equivalent
Vietnam	Completion of Year 11: GPA 6.5 or completion of Year 12: GPA 4.0
UK education system	GCSE: Five passes
Zimbabwe	Zimsec/GCE O levels: Five passes

To attain entry, you must demonstrate you have suitable level of English proficiency of IELTS 5.5 (with a minimum of 5.5 in all components) for Foundation. We offer Pre-sessional English courses as well. For the full list of entry requirements and for information on our Pre-sessional English course, please visit port.ac.uk/icp.

All students will need to demonstrate competency in both Maths and Chemistry to be considered for this course. Students should also be aware that the grades required to progress to Year 1 from Foundation are higher for the Pharmacy course modules than for the other articulations in the Science pathway.
